ORDINANCE
#1210-2025

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CLINTON IN HUNTERDON COUNTY, NEW JERSEY, INCREASING RATES AND CHARGES FOR EMPLOYMENT OF OFF-DUTY POLICE OFFICERS AND AMENDING SECTION 4-52 OF THE "CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CLINTON" ACCORDINGLY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Clinton, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Hourly rate and per-vehicle charge for employment of off-duty police officers increased and section 4-52H(7) of the Code amended. Section 4-52H(7) of Chapter 4, "Administration of Government," Article X, "Department of Public Safety" of the "Code of the Township of Clinton" ("Code") is hereby amended as follows (deleted text is in brackets [thus]; new text is underlined thus):

Chapter 4. Administration of Government

Article X. Department of Public Safety

§ 4-52. Division of Police.

(A. through G. no changes)

H. Off-duty employment.

((1) through (6) no changes)

(7) Payment requirement; escrow accounts.

((a) through (d) no changes)

(e) Salary and fee schedule. Contractors hiring Township police officers for off-duty employment shall be charged pursuant to the following schedule, which includes an hourly rate of pay for the police officer, the cost for the use of a police vehicle, plus a fair and reasonable sum representing the administrative costs, overhead and out-of-pocket expenses to the Township for

providing this service:

- [1] Personnel: [~~\$75~~]\$85.00 per hour per full-time police officer at any site.
- [2] Vehicles: [~~\$50~~]100.00 per [~~car~~]vehicle. This fee shall not apply to any public-school-sponsored event on public school property within Clinton Township.
- [3] Administration fee: 20% of the total fee as outlined above. If said service is requested within eight hours of the desired start time, an additional [~~\$75~~]\$85.00 shall apply.



Section 2. Repealer. All ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed as to such inconsistencies only.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion thereof.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect 20 days after final passage in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:69A-181.

The foregoing ordinance was introduced on first reading at the May 14, 2025 meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Township of Clinton. It will be further considered for final passage following a public hearing thereon to be held on **May 28, 2025, at 7:00 p.m.**, on the third floor of the Clinton Township Public

Safety Building, 1370 Route 31 North, Annandale, NJ 08801, at which time and place anyone from the public wishing to be heard will be permitted to ask questions or offer comments regarding the ordinance. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting and public hearing, copies of the full ordinance will be available at no cost during regular business hours in the Office of the Township Clerk for members of the public who shall request a copy of same. The purpose of the ordinance is to increase the rate for the employment of off-duty police officers from \$75 per hour to \$85 per hour, and to increase the vehicle charge from \$50 to \$100 per vehicle.
