**ORDINANCE
1214 – 2025**

**CAPITAL ORDINANCE FOR POLICE VEHICLES AND A LOADER BY THE
TOWNSHIP OF CLINTON, IN THE COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, NEW JERSEY,
APPROPRIATING THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$320,000.00, WHICH IS FROM THE
GENERAL CAPITAL FUND, CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CLINTON, IN THE
COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The various other improvement and equipment are hereby authorized as general improvements to be made or acquired by the Township of Clinton in the County of Hunterdon, New Jersey. For the said improvements or purposes stated in the said section 2, there is hereby appropriated the total sum of \$320,000.00; from monies available in the General Capital Fund, Capital Improvement Fund of the Township.

Section 2. The improvements hereby authorized and the purpose for which said appropriation is made are for the purchase of two vehicles for the Police Department and a loader for the Department of Public Works in the Township of Clinton.

Section 3. The capital budget or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing all detail of the amended capital budget or temporary capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of the Local Government Services are on file with the Township Clerk and are available for public inspection.


Section 4. The following additional matters are hereby determined, declared, recited and stated.


- (a) The said purpose described in Section 2 of the capital ordinance are capital expenses and are each a property, improvements or equipment including vehicles in which the Township may lawfully acquire or make as a general improvement, and no part of the cost thereof has been or shall be specifically assessed on property specially benefited thereby.
- (b) The average period of usefulness of said purposes within the limitations of said Local Bond Law and taking into consideration the respective amounts of the said obligations authorized for the several purposes, according to the

reasonable life thereof computed by this capital ordinance, at least five (5) years.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect after final adoption and publication and otherwise as provided by law.
