Salary and Wages and Fringe Benefits – increased 14.1%

Reason: Part-time help hired. Part-time help expected to work entire year in 2017. Part-time help expected to be needed more as part-time person becomes more familiar with processes and procedures.

Miscellaneous Appropriations decreased 20%

Reason: Larger planned computer upgrades and packages purchased in 2016. Less computer upgrades/packages expected to be purchased in 2017.

Maintenance Labor - Contracted - 27.5% increase

Misc - Maintenance and Repairs - Increased \$15,000 to \$30,000 for 2017

Misc – Geographical Information System – not budgeted for in 2017.

Reasons: Maintenance and repairs cost actual expenses in 2016 were larger than budgeted due to numerous pumps needing to be replaced. Budget adjusted to better align with prior year actual expenditures. The maintenance labor increases with the costs of repairs. However, the maintenance and repairs under the miscellaneous cost of providing services was primarily offset by the Geographical project cost of \$14,000 which is being completed in 2016.

Utilities - 11.1% increase

Reason: Increase in electric costs/usage - actual expenditures in 2016 anticipated to be greater than budgeted amount. 2017 budgeted appropriation to reflect continuation of higher utility appropriations.

User fees are expected to increase \$11,725 due to additional users, representing a 1% increase over 2016. \$136,108 of unrestricted net position has been utilized to stabilize rate increases.

There is no direct impact on the Authority.
