WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council find that Ms. Mekovetz should be entitled to these benefits, and therefore wish to amend the terms and conditions of her employment with the Township.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Clinton in Hunterdon County, New Jersey as follows:

1. The terms and conditions of the employment of Vita Mekovetz, RMC/MMC/QPA, as Township Administrator for the Township of Clinton, are amended as follows:
