Adoption of the 2023 Reexamination Report and the amendments to the Land Use Plan and Housing Plan elements of the Clinton Township Master Plan will be in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40:55D-89 and N.J.S.A. 40:55D-13 and -28.

Complete copies of the proposed 2023 Reexamination Report and the proposed amendments to the Land Use Plan and Housing Plan elements of the Clinton Township Master Plan will be on file and available for inspection at least ten days prior to the hearing at the Planning Board office located on the 1st floor of the Clinton Township Municipal Building, located at 1225 Route 31 South, Lebanon, New Jersey between the hours of 9:00am to 3:30pm, Monday through Friday. At the time of the public hearing any interested persons may appear and present any comments in support of, or in opposition to the adoption of the 2023 Reexamination Report and/or the amendments to the Land Use Plan and Housing Plan elements of the Clinton Township Master Plan in accordance with the rules of the Planning Board.
